TO DETERMINE BLOUSE SIZE:

Using a tailor's tape measure, measure the circumference of your waist and hip. Look for the approximate measurement on the chart and cross-reference to the appropriate pant/skirt size. Hip size will be the determining factor if waist and hip criteria do not correspond in the chart. All measurements are in inches. **M**=Misses/**W**=Woman

MALE A.F. SIZING INFORMATION

To Determine Trouser Length

The following represents body inseam measurements with appropriate trousers size length. For waist sizes measure waist and add 1 inch. Trousers run small.

- 26 to 28 inch inseam requires size – **XS**
- 28 to 30 inch inseam requires size – **S**
- 30 to 32 inch inseam requires size – **R**
- 32 to 34 inch inseam requires size – **L**
- 34 to 36 inch inseam requires size – **XL**

To Determine Shirt Size

Using a tailor's tape measure, measure the circumference of the cadet's neck. Add an additional ½ inch to that measurement (Shirt runs small). Look for the approximate measurement on the uniform voucher.

HAT SIZE CONVERSION CHART

Using a tailor's tape measure, measure the circumference of the cadet's head. Look for the approximate measurement on the chart and cross-reference to the appropriate cap size.

HOW TO MEASURE

A. NECK SIZE: Measure neck as illustrated, holding tape snugly. Read number of inches as size.

B. SLEEVE LENGTH: Measure arm as illustrated, hold arm chest high, bent slightly at elbow. Measure from bottom of collar at center of back around elbow to far end of wristbone.

C. CHEST SIZE: Place tape measure around fullest part of chest and over clothing to be worn, keeping it up under arms and around the shoulder blades. Number of inches is your size.

D. WAIST SIZE: Measure waist as illustrated just above top of hipbones. Read number of inches as size.

E. SEAM: Measure inseam as illustrated from base of crotch seam to the top of the shoe to be worn. Number of inches is your size. Flare bottom slacks should be worn about one inch longer than tapered bottom slacks for the correct fashion fit.

A. BUST: Measure around shoulder blades, under the arms and around the fullest part of the bust.

B. WAIST: Measure around the narrowest part of the natural waistline.

C. HIPS: Measure around the fullest part of the hips - normally 7 to 8 inches below natural waistline.

D. INSEAM: Measure inseam as illustrated from base of crotch seam to the top of the shoe to be worn. Number of inches is your size. Flair-bottom slacks should be worn about one inch longer than tapered bottom slacks for the correct fashion fit.

NOTE: Because women's figures may vary and different types of garments are designed to fit the figure in various ways, this information should be used only as a guide.
